



2. The British Security Service (B.S.S.) has reported that at
1005 GMT on 23 November an anonymous telephone call was made in
Cambridge, England, to the editor reporting of the Cambridge News. The
caller said only that the Cambridge News reporter should call the
American Embassy in London for more information and then hang up.

3. After the word of the President's death was received the re-
porter informed the Cambridge police of the anonymous call and the
police informed B.S.S. The report's point is that the call was made,
according to B.S.S. information, about 25 minutes before the President
was shot. The Cambridge reporter had never received a call of this
kind before and B.S.S. state that he is known to them as a good and loyal
person with an average mind.

4. B.S.S. noted that similar anonymous phone calls of a strongly
confrontational nature have been received by persons in the U. S. over the
past year, particularly in connection with the case of Dr. King.

5. The British Security Service stated its desire to assist in
every possible way in any following investigations required within
the United Kingdom.






